Nice Photos, but Poor Choices in Picking What to UseBy Michael StradfordI was anticipating this book for a long time, with a bit of trepidation, when I realized that Greg Williams wouldn't be the author for the first time in several Bond films. As a result, 'Blood, Sweat and Bond' is a bit of a let down. To be sure, there is a selection of great photos, but out of 200 pages, the amount of space devoted to the crew

vs. the cast and scenes from the film, is way out of whack. Shot after shot of nameless crew members, who definitely do important jobs, but are not the reason most Bond fans would buy this book. The text that greets each chapter is interesting, but presented in incredibly tiny fonts against a red background, makes it a difficult read. Unlike the Greg Williams Bond books, this one is curated by noted photographer Rankin and features the work of several accomplished shooters.
