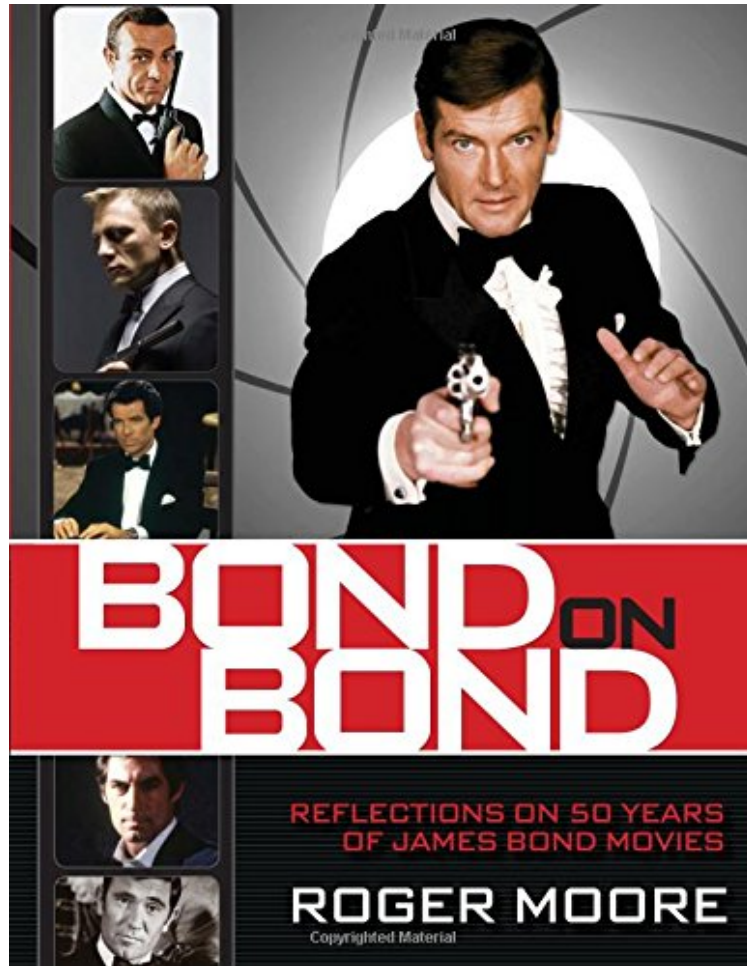

In this funny, heartwarming, and absolutely fascinating look back at the James Bond franchise, there is little in the way of dirt to be dished ("I'll simply leave it there," is Sir Roger's approach to two of his leading ladies who were, one assumes, less than agreeable) so don't pick this up expecting a kiss-and-tell expose. What you're getting instead is a guided tour of 007's cinematic journey, given by one of the men who actually packed the Walther PPK himself. There are a lot of smiles to be had as Sir Roger recounts his story, talking about the various players, props, characters, and other Bondania that he and his fellow 007s ran into over the years. Amusing, thoughtful and never mean spirited although I'd love to hear him dish about Grace Jones. His take on all of the actors who have played Bond is thoughtful and it's fun and surprising when he dishes on himself and when even he thought he was too old to play Bond (see the one off cartoons that take potshots at him for being an AARP Bond).
