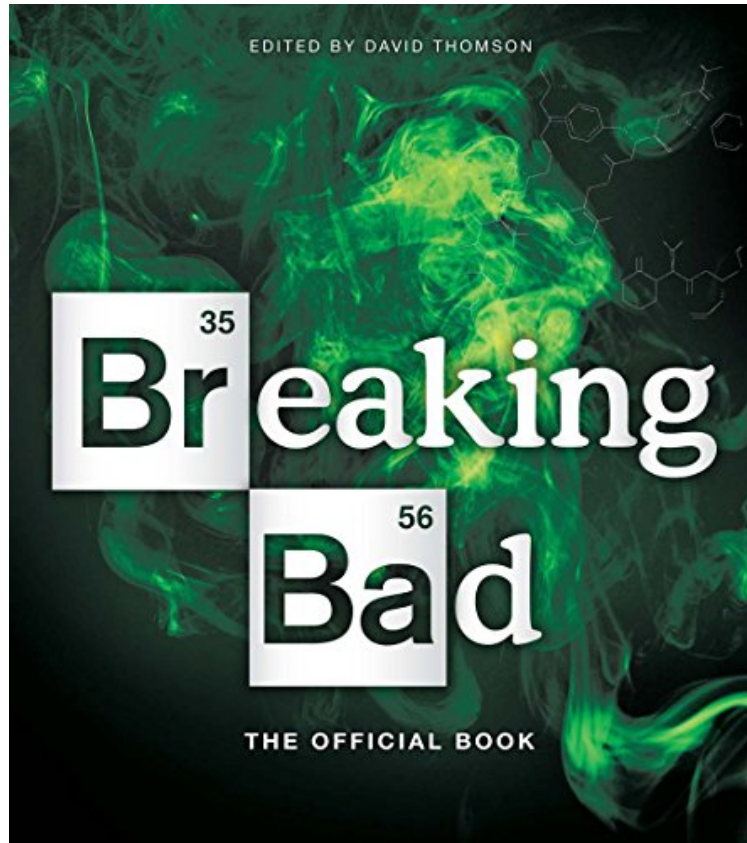

And *Crystal Clear* is a visual treat that spotlights the show's striking cinematography.
