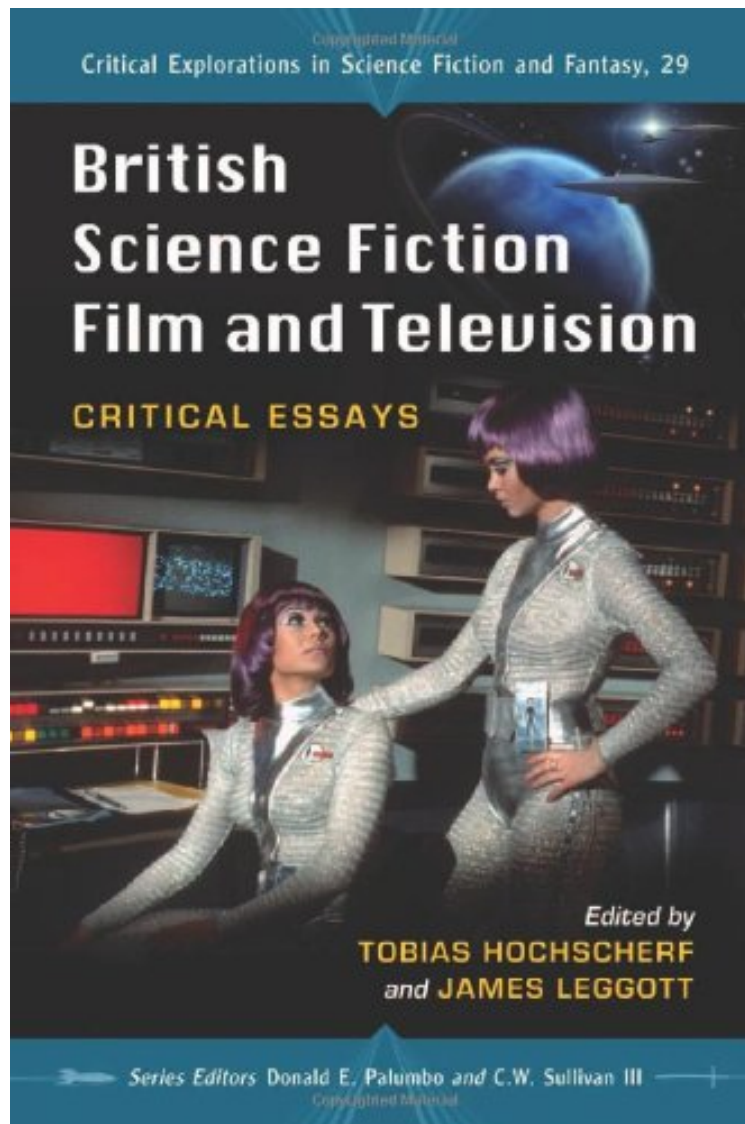


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British Science Fiction Film and Television: Critical Essays (Critical Explorations in Science Fiction and Fantasy)
