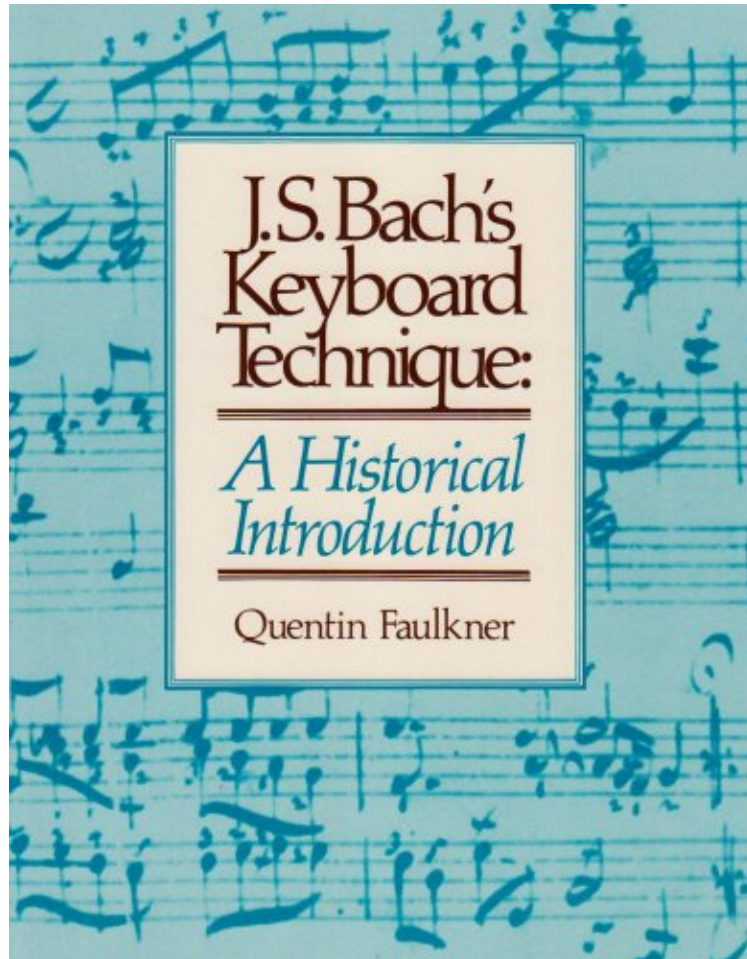

Very interesting By Thoraro This book is a collection of direct quotations from contemporary references (a treat to read), offered in the original German, along with translations and the author's comments and deductions. It contains a number of musical examples, demonstrating Bach's fingering principles and a chapter on Bach's footwork on the organ. A very interesting book for anyone playing Bach, or indeed any Baroque music, on the harpsichord or organ. It is a short (but dense) read, only 40 pages not counting the TOC and appendices.
