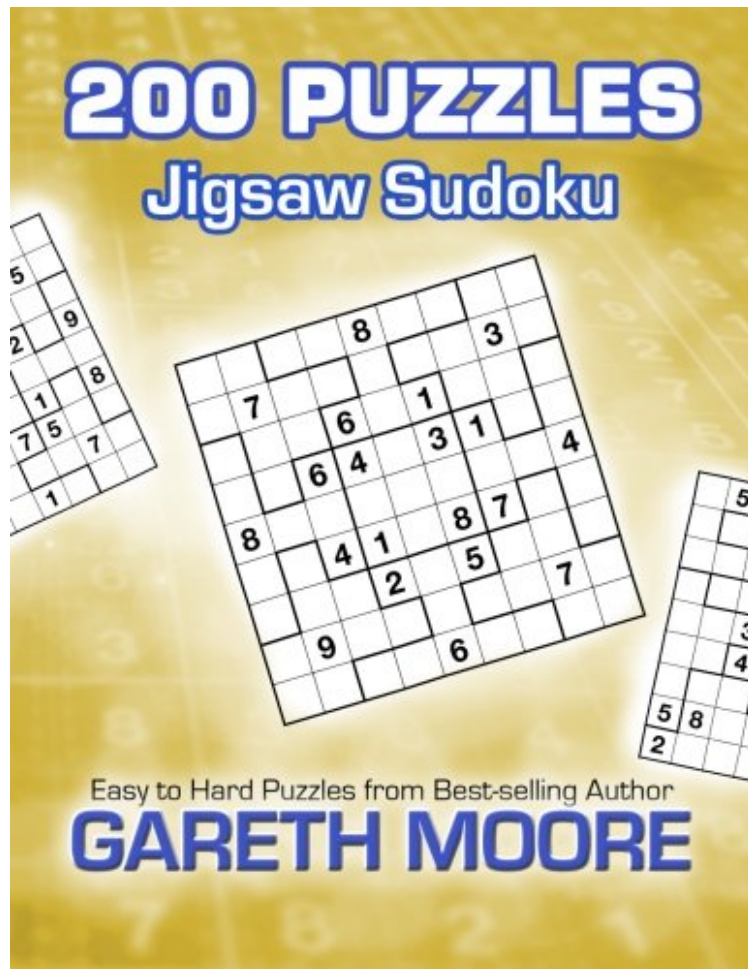

I don't think there is a wide range of difficulty, however, though it is touted on the cover; the puzzles all seem to be moderately difficult, with none very easy and none super hard. Still, I enjoyed this book very much.
