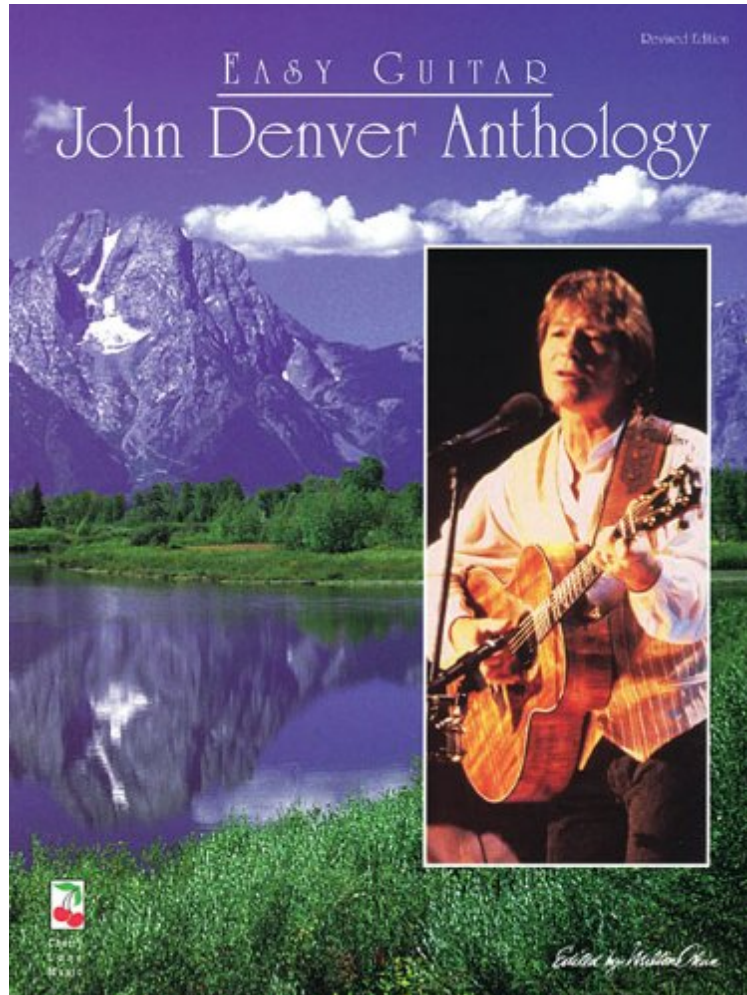

I can't say much about the chords since I use the melody lines on my mandolin, but my sister plays them on her guitar and they are well matched with the song. :D One correction for the book, using the melody line, the notes are not what the cds sound like. This is because its an 'easy guitar' book, so the publishers did not want it arranged with too difficult of notes. The tones are the same, but the note value is not like the song John Denver played. Once you've heard the cds, its nothing to just play the notes the way they are supposed to sound using their straight quarter notes on the page. It is a very good book, and to use two instruments in it is really nice. I reccomend the book for easy to memorize campfire songs.
