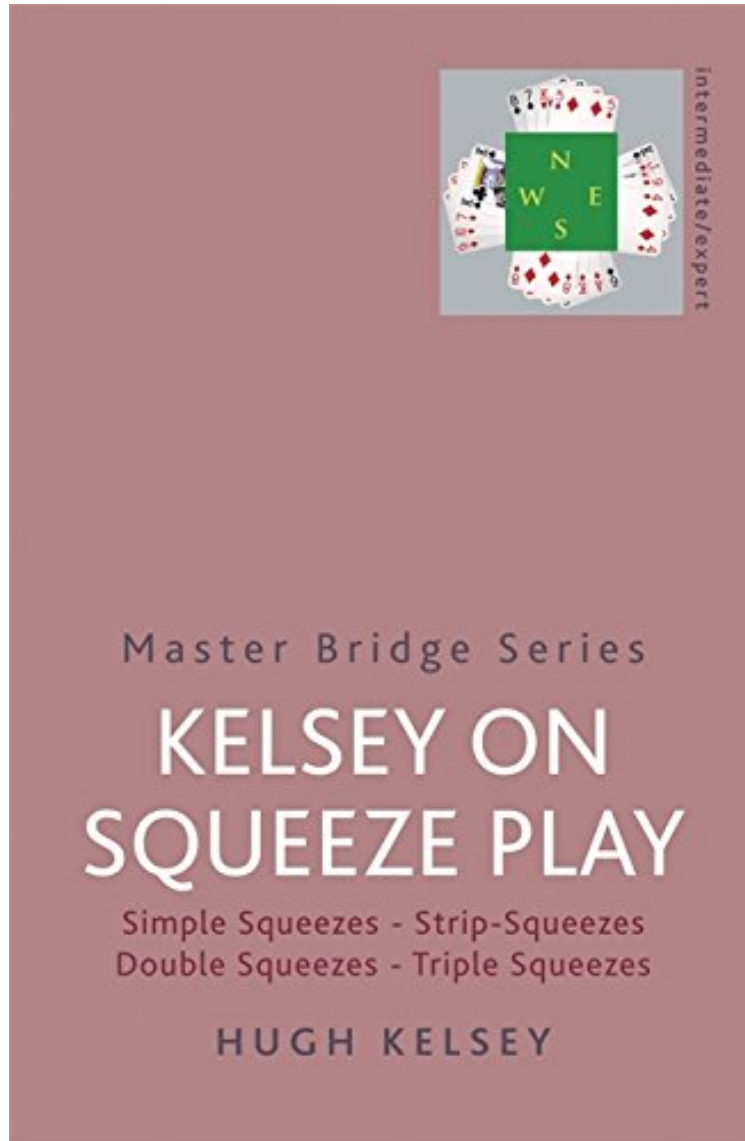

called). This book (actually 4 books) covers a wide range of squeezes. Its fascinating reading (if you are interested in squeeze play, and covers squeeze defense, and has a quiz at the end of each book. Each book also covers many squeezes you will see just a few times in your life, if you are a very good player. The book spends a lot of time on squeezes that you will likely never see in your life. In that sense it's a reference book, since the Reese book is more practical. This is not a super hard book, it's just long, and requires patience and visualization skills. Recommended for advanced players (and advanced intermediates)

The ability to understand and execute squeezes is widely recognized as the hallmark of an expert bridge player. Here for the first time in one volume are Hugh Kelsey's four outstanding books on the squeeze play: Simple Squeezes, Strip Squeezes, Double Squeezes, and Triple Squeezes.
