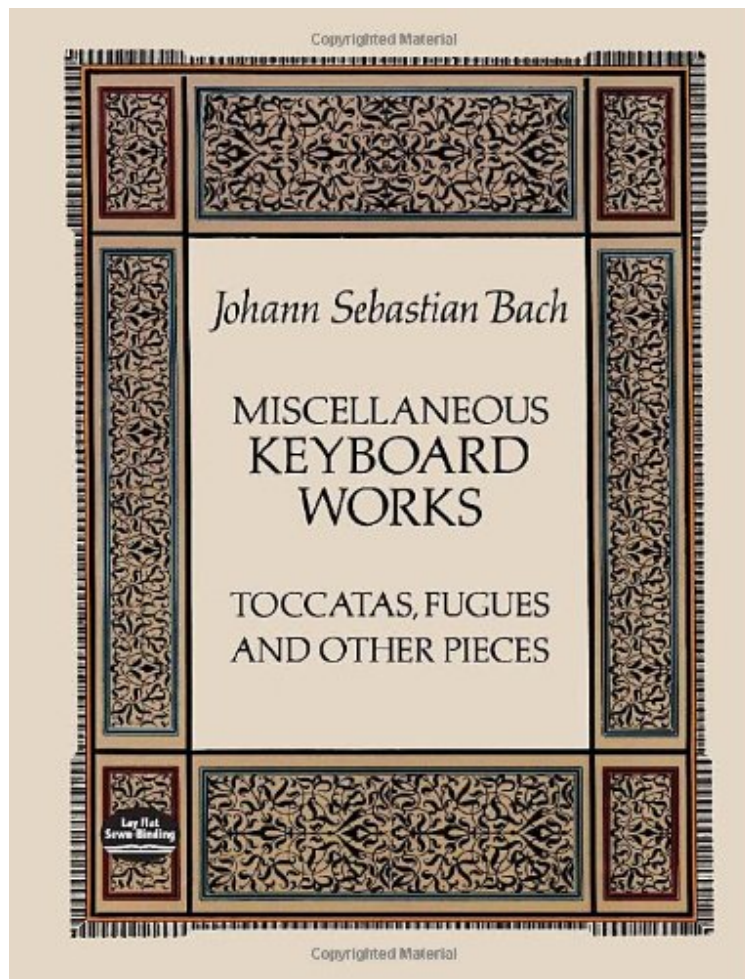

I have been searching for a book that contains excellent print quality for the seven Toccatas and this is it after purchasing 3 other books with very spotty and splotchy print. The quality of the print and the size of the scores in Dover's book is a wonderful change - easy to read. There are no notes or fingering, so individuals who insist on these

additions are out of luck, but many other public domain pdf books of these works exist (on IMSLP.org) that one can reference for such details. Without these items, the scores are very clean and crisp, making it much easier to play. There are many pieces in this books that one would rarely find, including the Six Little Preludes BWV 933-938 and the Five Preludes, BWV 939-943. F. Bach, the Aria Variata, etc. While the "major" keyboard pieces are available in other Dover volumes, this is great to look around in for lesser known works-- and some pieces scholars now attribute to other composers. This volume brings together a wide selection of Bach's keyboard compositions, including many pieces difficult to find in other editions. Included are several well-known works: the important harpsichord toccatas, the Capriccio on the Departure of His Most Beloved Brother, the Aria Variata alla Maniera Italiana, and the Six Little Preludes, as well as many lesser-known but significant pieces fugues, sonatas, and other works over 40 in all. Reprinted from the authoritative Breitkopf and Hrtel edition, the music in this inexpensive yet well-made volume offers pianists a rich selection of interesting works stamped with the melodic and rhythmic invention and harmonic audacity characteristic of Bach.

About the Author Johann Sebastian Bach (1685-1750) was a prolific German composer and organist whose sacred and secular works for choir, orchestra, and solo instruments exemplify the heart and soul of the Baroque period. A revival of interest and performances of his music began early in the 19th century and continue to this day. He is now widely considered to be one of the greatest composers in the Western tradition.
