By Robert I wish to complain about this CD that I purchased not half an hour ago from this very boutique! My complaint is that it took me so long to find the very first Monty Python album on CD. It took many many years to find it. The album was simply called MONTY PYTHON'S FLYING CIRCUS and in the USA it was released on the BBC label. Not sure which label it was on in the UK. However, this album was my first Monty Python album. It's not in stereo, and has never been in stereo, and was likely put together with audio recordings from the BBC TV show. At any rate, this was a fantastic discovery for me to find this album on CD. Oddly it is

packaged more like an audio book would be. This 3 CD set contains DISC 1 - the Monty Python's Flying Circus album, exactly as released on vinyl so long ago. DISCS 2 3 are audio recordings of two episodes of FAWLTY TOWERS, the British comedy program with John Cleese and Connie Booth. AudioGo has combined the BBC audiobooks of Monty Python's Flying Circus and Fawlty Towers, Volume 1 into one package. The Monty Python audiobook contains the first Monty Python's Flying Circus album released by the BBC in 1970. Fawlty Towers, Volume 1 contains audio versions of the episodes "Communication Problems (Mrs. Richards)", "The Hotel Inspectors", "Basil The Rat", and "The Builders" on two CDs (two episodes per CD). All of four episodes contain introductions from John Cleese and narration from Andrew Sachs, in character as Manuel. The material is quite funny, although it should be accepted for what it is. The Monty Python album contains by-the-numbers routines from the TV show. While they are classics, the album, as a whole, is not quite as inventive as subsequent albums. The Fawlty Towers material is obviously missing the visual humor from the show, but the episodes translate surprisingly well to an audio-only presentation. The packaging is a simple audiobook configuration without booklet or any artwork from the original LPs that these programs were gleaned from. Only a minimal amount of information is provided on the back. It is, however, a very economical way of acquiring this material.
