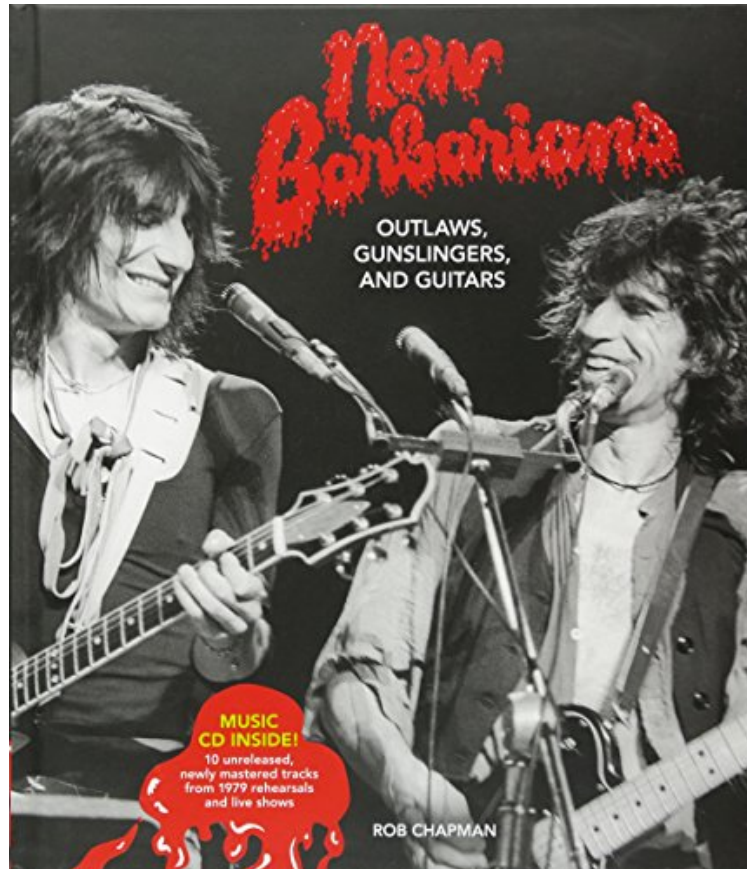

Ron Wood.I've been a fan of this band since they first began releasing live sets from their 1979 U.S. tour. but I have to say that I was surprised to see a book about the band and tour. But I'm happily surprised that the book is no thrown together mess. Rather it's a well thought out, in depth look at Ron Woods' "side band" featuring Woods and Keith Richards-guitars/vocals, Bobby Keys-sax, Stanley Clarke-bass, Ian McLagan-keyboards, and Joseph Modeliste-drums.The many photos and other graphics are crisp and clean. The text is interesting and informative. The layout of the book is well done. Plus you get a ten track (52 + minutes) CD of unreleased tunes. But I'd advise you to take the disc out of the plastic envelope glued into the inside back cover and put it in a jewel case. The sound, while not pristine, is as good as anything (at least to my ears) that's been previously

released--especially the latest live set. There's a real sound and feel of real rock 'n' roll across all ten tracks--nothing fancy--just great shakin' rock 'n' roll. For fans of the New Barbarians (and the Rolling Stones) how can you lose? The band was never really well documented, so this great book filled with many previously unseen photos of the band on and off the stage, plus a few photos of the Stones, and ephemera (including some of Woods' artwork, ticket stubs, T-shirts hand written lyric sheets, etc.) , and the inside story of the band finally shines some light on this short lived band. And with relatively little of the band's music having been recorded/issued, the inclusion of a CD is very cool and a welcome addition to the band's discography. The book includes, in both text and photos, the band's formation and subsequent tour of Canada, America, an opening slot for Led Zeppelin at the '79 Knebworth Festival, and their final gig in Milwaukee, Wisc. in 1980, plus a look at the band off-stage. Fans of the band will want this great book, but for anyone who hasn't heard the New Barbarians this book and, equally importantly the smokin' CD will give you a good idea of what went on in '79.
