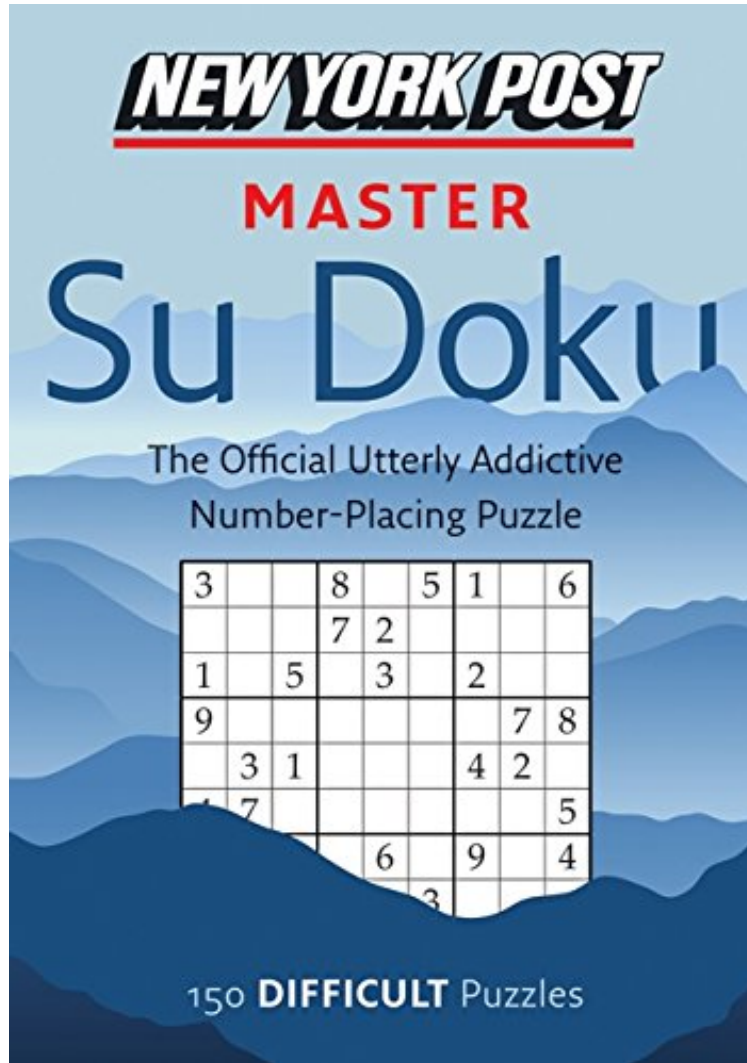

By Nate The New York Post Sudoku books are a lot better than the cheap ones you can find in the grocery store. I think the main reason is that the puzzles seem to be designed and tested by a person, and those seem to be generated randomly by a computer. These feel like each one has a specific challenge built in to it, so that as you go through a book it feels like you are improving, learning new tricks for solving the Sudoku puzzles. My wife and I like to buy two copies of the same puzzle book and then we can challenge each other by playing the same puzzle and seeing who gets

through it first. Sometimes we decide upon a prize for the winner; other times it's just for the fun of it. The "Difficult" level puzzles are about right for that purpose -- they each offer a bit of a challenge, but not an impossible challenge. If you have a bit of practice in Sudoku, the puzzles at the "Difficult" level can usually be solved without taking any notes and without erasing. That, in my mind, makes it more fun. When you have to take copious notes in each box to solve a puzzle, it feels like work. The point of this is that you need to be mentally active, but it is still fun. (I will say that this particular "Difficult" book seems a bit easier than some of the other "Difficult"-level books from the New York Post Sudoku series that we've tried.) 0 of 0 people found the following review helpful.
