continues the lessons with a focus on learning to read music. It was during this series that he really got the hang of sight reading by reinforcing his ability to quickly determine each note in each clef - this made his overall playing better. By working on his Notespeller homework (which can be done anywhere, doesn't need to be near the piano) - my son was able to further his learning at a quicker pace. Best for me - during his lessons, his teacher spent more time working on other aspects of his playing and less time on note recognition - making the money I spend on lessons go to better use. I highly recommend the Notespeller series.
