By Steve Ramm: This is another of the CD collections from Highbridge Audio consisting of audio excerpts from NPR's news programs like All Things Considered, Weekend Edition and Fresh Air with Terry Gross. While I prefer the serious discussions or even better the great comic moments, I did enjoy this volume. The 150-minute (on 2 CDs) is filled with 21 segments (each given a brief introduction by Allison Aubrey and Dan Charles). Some last as long as 15 minutes and some are just under two minutes in length. In MOST cases the person interviewed (they are mostly interviews) is promoting a new book or possibly a TV show. Top Chef Marcus Samuelson (promoting his auto bio) talks about his life in Ethiopia and Sweden before coming to the US. Two interviewees talk about Soul Food and southern cooking. Gourmet Ruth Reichel talks about her early career and provides a quick easy recipe. And then there is a 2009 interview segment (nearly 15 minutes) with Julia Child on how she got hooked on French cooking. The segments date from 2009 through June 2015. I mention having a pen and paper (or pencil) handy because there are a few recipes given or you might want to jot down the name of the book being discussed. Whatever you do, make sure you've eaten recently or listen while eating. The descriptions will certainly get your taste buds
